What is the program?

The course offers a positive and interactive learning experience with activities designed to be informative and stimulating.

- The program aims to raise awareness that parents have the lead role in promoting their child's development.
- Provides understanding of age and stage of development
- Considering a child's needs and how to meet them
- Promotes understanding of importance of play experience for children's learning
- Provide strategies to improve parent/ child interaction.
- Helps strengthen parent/child relationships to promote positive behaviour
- Raise awareness of the getting it right for every child and Curriculum for Excellence language used in health, education and social work services.

Who is it for?

The programme is suitable for parents/carer's of children from 0 to age 8 who have/are experiencing some challenges with parenting and would like to learn how to support positive development for their child

Set up of the group:

The group runs for 9 weeks and each session is 2 hours

The sessions are delivered by Family Support Hub staff and provide an interactive approach to understanding children's development which are fun and informative with opportunities for parents/carer's to practice new skills at home with their child.
