Mrs. Boyle advised it was a pleasure to be able to welcome so many parents and children into the school again for the P7 Lockerbie Manor Meeting. There was a good response to

Mr. Bradley has returned to the school to provide music tuition for P6 pupils.

Further to the previous query regarding transport for children from Persimmon Homes off Duke Street, Mrs. Boyle advised that parents are required to apply for this on an individual basis. Further information will be shared to parents via the School App.

The school has booked a Pantomime for all children to attend over two afternoons this Christmas. Mrs. Boyle advised they have sourced funding to cover the cost of the transport so the cost per child will be reduced to $\pounds 6.00$. More details will follow nearer the time.
