<u>Allergies</u>

On Friday 29th April we held an Allergy Awareness assembly with all our school pupils. The assembly shared the importance of not sharing snacks and what needs to be done if a friend has an allergic reaction. As part of this awareness raising, I'd like to remind everyone that that school is a **nut free zone**. This ensures the safety of all our children and staff. Snacks and packed lunches should not contain nuts or products containing nuts. This includes Nutella and Kinder Bueno snacks as examples.
